An experimental bus service between Greenfield Station, Dovestone and Uppermill started on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> June. The service will run each Saturday and Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday until 26<sup>th</sup> September.

The bus stops at The Clarence, Greenfield and Greenfield Conservative Club in both directions. The fare is £1 per day but free with an "over 60" pass and to holders of a valid rail or bus ticket to Saddleworth.

A Park and Ride is available at Saddleworth Rangers Ground near to Greenfield Station. Parking is free
