192. Requests for financial Assistance

At the previous meeting members considered a request for assistance in the purchase of a data projector, the matter was deferred until financial statements were supplied by the organisation. These documents have now been received. The Committee agreed to make a grant of £200.

Delph Senior Citizens Association

A request for assistance towards the costs of the Christmas / New Year festivities was considered by the Committee. It was agreed to make a grant of £200.

North West Air Ambulance

The Committee considered a request for assistance towards the cost of the North West Air Ambulance. It was agreed to make a grant of £200.

193. Notice boards

David Courtman is preparing a quotation for the supply and erection of the notice boards in Denshaw and at the Civic Hall. He will not be able to carry out the work until early in the New Year. David will also be asked to carry out maintenance work on the existing notice boards.

194. Newsletter
