- 189. Update on previous minutes** – none
- 190. Civic Hall Modernisation Phase 2** – The tenders were returned yesterday, the Architect and Q.S. have requested additional information from the two lowest tenderers, they will then draw up a list of proposals.
- 191. Intruder alarm and CCTV system** – deferred until details of the work to be undertaken on the building have been finalised.
- 192. Car Parking at the Civic Hall** – Oldham Council intends to introduce time-limited parking in car parks in all district centres, including Uppermill. A number of companies operate “self ticketing” schemes that would allow the Parish Council to manage the usage of the Civic Hall car park. It was agreed that the Clerk will obtain details of the cost of the schemes and that the Civic Hall staff will monitor the number of vehicles that are left overnight on the car park.
- 193. Repairs / Renewals in the Civic Hall** – estimates are being obtained for the provision of a barrier between the two lower halls and for the creation of a storage area adjacent to the lift in the foyer.
